IFEC Accreditation Result

IFEC (Ivry and Toulouse) has recently submitted a self-study report and undergone an evaluation visit as part of an application for re-accreditation with the European Council on Chiropractic Education (ECCE) in accordance with the ECCE Standards (<http://www.cce-europe.org/downloads.html>). At its meeting on Saturday 7 February 2015 in London, the Commission on Accreditation agreed to approve re-accreditation for the maximum period of 5 years.

The CoA expects, in response to recommendation 5.2.1.1 of the evaluation report, that IFEC ensure comparability of teaching and assessment across both sites, Ivry and Toulouse, and that external examiners are appointed by November 2015.

IFEC was commended on the dedicated leadership provided by Senior Management in collaboration with AFEFC to raise the academic standards and profile of chiropractic within France. Further, the Team noted the excellent clinical training and clinic facilities at both sites including placements in hospitals, and the excellent IT infrastructure that underpins teaching and learning on the programme.
